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arris Teeter combines the best of the old and new at its store in Nashville, Tenn.

The design for the 25,000-sq.-ft. supermarket, located in a historic setting, incorporates the language of the local architectural vernacular and utilizes modern and traditional materials to create a unique, consumer-friendly space. A sweeping, two story glass and aluminum elevation capped with an exposed steel wave of roof marries the first-floor market with the second-floor leased office space. On the interior, a large vertical expanse of soffit wall provides the backdrop for suspended decor mural boards that display sepia-toned images from old photos of the neighborhood. ■
