Design and development award for Hill Center at Green Hills

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Dec. 23, 2010 – The [International Council of Shopping Centers](#) (ICSC) recently recognized [H.G. Hill Realty Company](#) as part of their 2010 U.S. Design and Development Awards program.

A Silver Award was given to the company for the Hill Center at Green Hills in the Innovative Design and Development of a New Project under 150,000 sq. ft total retail space category.

The 220,000 sq. ft. mixed-use lifestyle center, which opened in 2007, contains 136,559 sq. ft. of retail space and consists of 27 stores. Modeled after a tree-lined main street, Hill Center is designed with a mix of traditional storefronts and contemporary architecture to ensure that future additions can be easily integrated into the landscape.
