

# Memphis clothier Oak Hall opens in Nashville

[Oak Hall](#), a 157-year-old Memphis clothier operated by fifth- and sixth-generation owners, has opened its doors in Nashville.

The retailer took over the 2,000-square-foot space formerly occupied by Merrell Footwear & Apparel at 4017 Hillsboro Pike at the Hill Center Green Hills shopping center.

In fall 2017, Oak Hall will take over adjacent spaces occupied by Bink's Outfitters, E.J. Sain Jewelers and Johnston & Murphy to build a 10,000-square-foot store.

"We are excited to bring our Memphis flagship's long-standing values, exceptional service and world-class style offerings to Nashville," Oak Hall president Will Levy said in a statement.

The Nashville store sells men's clothing, furnishings and sportswear, along with women's ready-to-wear collections. Brands in the store include Ermenegildo Zegna, Canali, Samuelsohn, Peter Millar, Hiltl, Eton, Barbour, Faherty, AG, Rag and Bone, Rebecca Taylor and Vince.

To celebrate the opening, 10 percent of total sales will be donated to various local charities from April 3-9.

The Levy family also owns the Vineyard Vines store at Hill Center Green Hills.

Owned by H.G. Hill Realty Company, the Hill Center Green Hills mixed-use outdoor lifestyle center is anchored by Anthropologie and Whole Foods and features more than 20 specialty shops and four restaurants.
