

# Six New Businesses Coming To Hillsboro Village Development

*NASHVILLE, Tenn.* – It's out with the old and in with the new in Hillsboro Village.

Developers behind Hill Center Acklen, a new 13,000 square foot mixed-use development in Hillsboro Village, announced six new retail tenants will be moving into the building at the corner of 21st Avenue South and Acklen Avenue.

New additions include a sports bar called Double Dogs Chow House, a coffee shop called Revelator Coffee, and a fashion boutique called Native + Nomad, another Jeni's Splendid Ice Creams location, Uncle Classic Barbershop, and Pilates Garage.

"I think it's going to be one of the coolest projects we've ever done," said Jimmy Granbery, CEO of H.G. Hill Realty Company. "This type of development makes economic sense, to have underground parking with residential on top of retail."

The project also features 42 one and two bedroom apartments.

Two open retail spaces remain at Hill Center Acklen. Developers said they working to fill those spaces.

Area business owners were happy to hear of the new additions moving to the neighborhood.

"I think the whole village is excited about it," said Stephanie Powers, Store Manager at The Impeccable Pig. "If you are going to come and check out a new shopping district, I hope a bigger and more diverse community will bring more people in."

The construction on Hill Center Acklen is expected to be complete in the Spring, and residents should be able to begin moving into the apartments in April.
